Graduation time is here!

Here is a list of items to consider:

A. Before your last day of school:

1. All fines, fees, and other balances must be paid prior to practice.
2. All books must be turned in prior to practice.

B. Practice day:

1. Practice is mandatory, unless excused by the principal.
2. It will be held in the gym on Friday, May 18, 2018.
3. You need to report to the gym at 12:50 p.m. Please be on time.
4. There will be a senior walk-through at the elementary. You will need to bring your cap and gown for this. The bus leaves promptly at 2:55 to go to the elementary.
5. Dress code still applies. Please no tank tops, shorts, hats, or any other items not allowed in the handbook.
6. Cell phones will need to be turned off.
7. Be on your best behavior. Handbook rules still apply.

C. Graduation day:

1. Graduation will be held at the gym on Sunday, May 20, 2018, at 3:00 p.m.
2. You need to report to the cafeteria at 2:00 p.m. Please be on time.
3. **Only students** will be allowed in the cafeteria prior to the program.
4. As this is a formal event, you will need to dress accordingly. Boys: dress pants, shirt, tie, and dress shoes (you may wear clean boots → no work boots) Girls: dress or dress pants and blouse, wear nice sensible shoes... you don't want to trip while walking on the stage. No flip flops. Let us know if you need help getting any of these items. Dress codes still apply.
5. Gowns need to be free of wrinkles. Girls: white collars need to be attached to gown unless you are National Honor Society.
6. Wear your ring for the ring-turning ceremony.
7. No cell phones will be allowed during the program. Have a family member keep it for you. If you have your cell phone with you, we will lock it in the journalism room before the ceremony starts and you will get it back when you come pick up your diploma.
8. This is a very formal and dignified ceremony. Be on your best behavior, please. Polite applause from family and friends is ALL that is required.
